HYDROGEN PEROXIDE USES

Laundry:

Add 1 cup of peroxide to your white clothes when washing them to help whiten them.

Also can be poured directly on clothing to get blood spot out. Let sit for a minute, then rub and rinse with cold water.

Repeat if needed.

Mouthwash:

Put up to one capful in mouth and swish around for up to 10 minutes. Spit all of it out when done. Then rinse mouth with water.

Vegetable Soak:

1/4 cup of 3% peroxide to a sink full of cold water.

Can soak vegetables for 20-30 minutes, depending on the thickness of skins.

Dishwasher:

Add 2 oz. of peroxide to your regular washing formula.

Sanitizing:

Keep a dark spray bottle of straight 3% peroxide to clean inside refrigerator, counters, table tops, glass and mirrors.

Store in cabinet out of light.

Dilute peroxide 50/50 with spring water to clean bathrooms.

Keep 1 spray bottle of peroxide and 1 spray bottle of vinegar.

Spray each on surface for a non toxic cleaner.

When they mix, for a brief time the chemical reaction of the two make a powerful sanitizer.

DO NOT mix them in the same bottle.
